OVERVIEW AND DESCRIPTION

Operating the DE-4000 Series Configurable Safety Shutdown and Control System via a computer running Microsoft Windows 10 requires a temporary change to the computer's IP address. This document outlines the steps necessary to accomplish this. The default IP address for the DE-4000 is 98.102.65.174



1.0 CLICK THE WINDOWS ICON

The Windows icon is in the bottom left corner of your computer screen.




2.0 CLICK ON CONTROL PANEL




3.0 CLICK ON NETWORK AND SHARING CENTER



4.0 CLICK ON CHANGE ADAPTER SETTINGS




5.0 RIGHT-CLICK ON ETHERNET




6.0 SELECT PROPERTIES


...from the drop-down menu.
